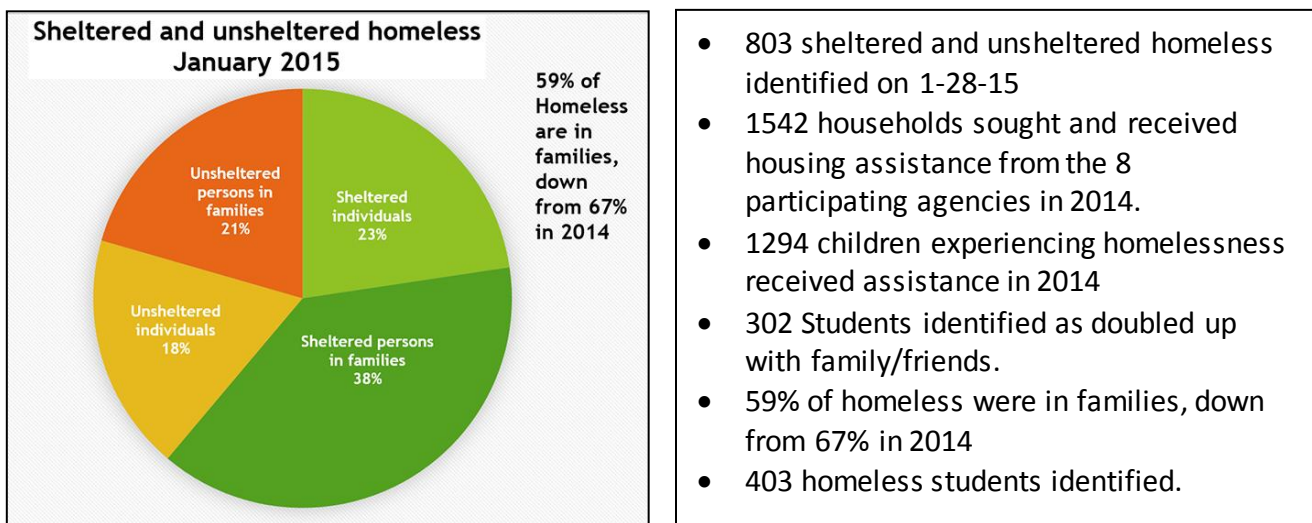




# SCB Mini Vinnies

The SCB Mini Vinnies were **Freez'n 4 A Reason** on November 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>. To raise awareness and understanding of the plight of those facing the condition of homelessness, students spent the evening outside in a "Box City". 37 Mini Vinnies and their sponsors used cardboard boxes for protection from the cold.

The students shared facts on the condition of homelessness in St. Charles County with the Borromeo parish community. The data shared was compiled during the point-in-time count held in St. Charles, Warren and Lincoln Counties January 28, 2015. This is a national yearly count of the homeless.



Carol Beckel, St. Patrick Center Board of Trustees joined the Vinnies Saturday evening to share information about services that the St. Patrick Center provides. For 32 years the St. Patrick Center has been serving those in need. The St. Patrick Center is the largest provider of homeless services in Missouri, with more than 20 programs that assist more than 9,000 persons annually who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

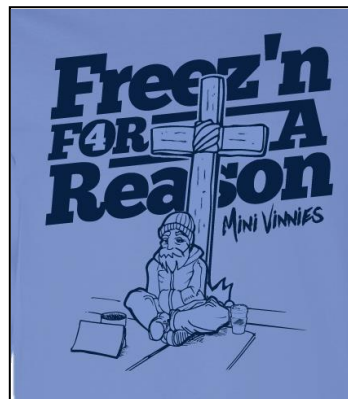
