

DAILY REFLECTIONS FOR THE SECOND WEEK OF ADVENT

The scripture readings this week are about preparing the way of the Lord—finding and making a space in our hearts for Christ. The Vincentian reflection/meditation from Sunday talks about the presence of Christ in our daily lives. Here are some short scripture or other quotes for your reflection this week:

+“Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect.” (Romans 12:1-2)

+“Let me hear what God the Lord will speak, for he will speak peace to his people, to his faithful, to those who turn to him in their hearts.” (Ps 85: 8)

+“Hope in God; I will praise him yet again, my saving presence and my God.” (Ps 42:5)

+“When silent and still we can hear his voice speaking to us through our weakness and inadequacy, coaxing our minds to look for one who will bring order into that inner chaos, but most of all to give forgiveness and encouragement. He speaks, too, through anguish and agony, to draw us away from what separates from him to turn to him for serenity and inner peace.” (Give us This Day, December, 2012, p.149)
